

Covid-19 CORONAVIRUS

New Government advice regarding the use of Play Parks

Scientific advice suggests that the COVID-19 virus can survive for up to several days on some hard surfaces. The risks are reduced when outdoors, where surfaces may be subject to UV light and/or rain. Whilst all possible practical measures have been put in place, the user of this equipment does so at their own choice and risk.

In order to keep everyone safe, please note the following guidance:

- ✓ Observe social distancing principles when entering and exiting the park, as there is only one entrance/exit
- ✓ Only have 1 family member accompanying a child
- ✓ No more than 10 people in the play park at any one time
- ✓ When waiting to use equipment, observe social distancing of 2m if possible and 1m with face coverings if not
- ✓ Take note of the signage on individual pieces of equipment and adhere to this advice

Please remember that:

- We are unable to clean the equipment and other facilities in the park. Please take steps to prevent contamination by washing your hands, using hand gel or wearing gloves which you then dispose of safely. Please use bins provided or take litter home.
 - It is your responsibility to maintain social distancing
 - No eating or drinking is permitted in the play park
 - We reserve the right to close the play park if this guidance is not followed.
